Ancre Hill Estates was established in 2006 by its owners Richard and Joy Morris and their family. It is located just north of Monmouth and they produce an award-winning range of white, red, rosé and sparkling wines on their 9 acres of vineyards. Since 2014 Ancre Hill Estates has been the only UK wine producer to farm 100% biodynamically and organically. Richard and Joy's son David took over winemaking in 2014 having trained at a number of wineries around the world. David designed and built an eco-winery in the vineyard which opened in 2015 and enables him to produce natural wines without chemicals and with the minimum possible technological intervention both in the vineyard and in the winery.
